Description

Front: Wagen (carpentum), gezogen von zwei Maultieren, nach r. Der Wagen ist mit Victorien und anderen Darstellungen verziert. Punze auf dem vorderen Maultier.

Rear: Umgeben von der Aufschrift ein großformatiges S C.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
