Front: Kopf des Domitius Alexander mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Alexander reitet nach r., die r. Hand grüßend erhoben (adlocutio).

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
