Front: Kopf des Domitianus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Minerva steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. gewandt. Ihre l. Hand ist in die Hüfte gestützt, mit ihrer r. Hand hält sie einen Speer.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
