Description

Front: Kopf der Demeter mit Ährenkranz und Schleier nach r. Gegenstempel mit Traube auf Hals und Wange.

Rear: Füllhorn (cornucopiae). Runder Gegenstempel mit Delphin unten.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
