Description

Front: Bärtiger Herculeskopf nach r. Vor dem Mund die Punze N.

Rear: Vier Priesterattribute: Schöpfkelle (simpuvium/simpulum), Weihwedel (aspergillum), Beil (sacena) und Priesterkappe (apex).

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
