Description

Front: Brustbild Ludwig des Frommen mit Lorbeerkranz und Kaisermantel (paludamentum) nach rechts.

Rear: Viersäuliger Tempel mit Kreuz in der Mitte und auf dem Giebel.

Looped: Modified with a loop fixed secondarily to a coin, for example in order for it to be suspended from a necklace.

Gilded: With an overlay (wholly or in parts) of a thin layer of gold. Process is not part of the regular production.
