Description

Front: Büste des Geta mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Helios mit Strahlenkrone steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach r. In seiner erhobenen r. Hand hält er eine Peitsche, der l. Arm ist gesenkt.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
