Front: Kopf des Divus Augustus mit Strahlenkrone nach r. Im r. F. ΦΙ.

Rear: Verschleierte und drapierte Büste der Tyche mit Mauerkrone nach r. Darunter ΔΙ.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
