Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Elagabalus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Heiliger Stein (baitylos), um welchen sich eine Schlagne windet. Palme l., r. davon eine Purpurschnecke.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
