Description

Front: Kopf des Constantinus II. mit Banddiadem nach r., der Kopf ist angehoben. Unten die Punze C.

Rear: Victoria geht nach l. Sie hält in ihrer r. Hand einen Kranz und mit ihrer l. Hand einen Palmzweig. Am Kranz die Punze C.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
