Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Anastasius I. mit Helm, Speer und Schild in der Frontalansicht, Kopf leicht nach r.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
