Rear: Zwei Victorien halten gemeinsam einen Schild mit der Aufschrift VOT / V / MVLT / X.  
Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
