## Description

Front: Vogel (Adler?) nach rechts.

Rear: Doppelfadenkreuz, in den Winkeln Ringel mit Punkt.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
