## Description

Front: Kopf des Herakles mit Löwenfellxuvie nach r.

Rear: Zeus Aetophoros sitzt auf einem Hocker (diphros) nach l., in der l. Hand ein Zepter. Im l. F. Λ, darunter eine Fackel. Unter dem Hocker ein Gefäß (kantharos).

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
