Description

Front: Kopf des Herakles mit Löwenfellxuvie nach r. Auf der Wange Punzen C und O.

Rear: Zeus Aetophoros sitzt auf einem Hocker (diphros) nach l., in der l. Hand ein Zepter. Im l. F. ein Hahn nach l.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
