Description

Front: Drapierte Büste (nach Vorbild des Hyrkodes) mit Diadem nach l.

Rear: Gottheit (?) mit Lanze in der r. Hand in der Vorderansicht.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
