Front: Kopf des Herakles mit Löwenfellxuvie nach r.

Rear: Zeus Aetophoros sitzt auf einem Thron nach l., in der l. Hand ein Zepter. Im l. F. ΑΙΝΗΤΩΡ, darunter eine Rose. Unter dem Thron ΠΟ.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
