## Description

Front: Kopf des Caracalla mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Getreidemaß (modius) mit Kornähren darin und seitlichen Henkeln.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
