Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Constantius II. mit glattem Diadem nach r.

Rear: Constantius II. steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. gewandt. Er hält ein Feldzeichen (vexillum) in seiner r. Hand. Hinter ihm l. zwei weitere Feldzeichen (vexilla).

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
