Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Constantius II. mit Diadem in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Victoria geht nach l. Sie hält in ihrer r. Hand ein Siegesmal (tropaeum) und einen Palmzweig im l. Arm. Im l. F. ein Stern, im r. F. LXXII.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
