Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Constantius II. mit Diadem in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Victoria geht nach l. Sie hält in ihrer r. Hand einen Kranz und in ihrem l. Arm einen Palmzweig.

Provenience: Mindestens seit 1872 im Bestand des Münzkabinetts.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Gilded: With an overlay (wholly or in parts) of a thin layer of gold. Process is not part of the regular production.
