Description

Front: Jugendlicher Kopf mit langem Haar und Schilfkranz nach r.

Rear: Kniender Herakles nach r. Er trägt das Löwenfell über dem Kopf und spannt seinen Bogen. Vor dem Bogen ein Delphin nach unten.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
