## Description

Front: Kreuz.

Rear: Ortsname um Karolus-Monogramm in Punktkreis.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
