Front: Kopf des Ptolemaios I. mit Diadem und Aegis nach r. Auf der Wange ein runder Gegenstempel ΠΑ oder ΠΓ.

Rear: Adler mit zusammengelegten Flügeln mit Blitzbündel in den Krallen nach l. Im l. F. M.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
