Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Iulianus in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Drei Feldzeichen (vexilla).

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Part(s) broken away: Sections of the coin or medal are broken away (without any traces of mechanic manipulation).
