Description

Rear: Ovaler vierfeldiger Schild von einem Kreuz geteilt. Oben das Münzstättenzeichen Fass. Über dem Schild die Punze XD.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
