Description

Front: Gestaffelt die Brustbilder des Wilhelm III. mit Lorbeerkranz (vorn), und der Maria II. (hinten) nach rechts.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
