Description

Front: Stehender Rudolf in der Vorderansicht. In seiner rechten Hand hält er ein geschultertes Schwert.

Rear: Unter einer Helmzier quergeteilter Wappenschild.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
