## Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Gratianus mit Diadem in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Vota-Aufschrift in einem Kranz.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Defaced: Parts of the image or inscription of a coin, medal or token have been removed/erased. To be used in particular for cases of damnatio memoriae. See also the concepts for re-cut/tooled and recut die.
