Description

Front: Im Feld Glaubenssätze, Kalifenname, innen umlaufend Prägeort und -jahr. Münzzeichen oben. Tuscheaufschrift 385.

Rear: Im Feld Glaubenssatz, Titel und Ehrenname und Kunya des Prägeherren, als Randschrift Qur'ān Sure IX,33.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Inscribed upon (by hand): An object has been inscribed by hand with ink etc.
