Description

Front: Im Feld Glaubenssätze, Ehrenname und Kunya des Familienoberhaupts, innen umlaufend Prägeort und -jahr, aussen umlaufend Koranzitat, Münzzeichen Punkt oben im Feld.

Rear: Im Feld Glaubenssatz, Kalifename, Ehrenname und Kunya des Prägeherren, als Randschrift Qur’ān Sure IX,33. Münzzeichen Punkt unten im Feld.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
