## Description

Front: Im Feld Glaubenssätze, Ehrenname und Kunya des Prägeherren, innen umlaufend Prägeort und -jahr, aussen umlaufend Koranzitat.

Rear: Im Feld Glaubenssatz, Kalifename, Ehrenname und Kunya des Familienoberhaupts. Als Randschrift Qur'ān Sure IX,33.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
