Description

Front: Im Feld Glaubenssätze, Name des Prägeherren, innen umlaufend Prägeort und -jahr, aussen umlaufend Koranzitat, darum am äußeren Rand Segensworte.

Rear: Im Feld Glaubenssatz, Kalifenname,#. Als Randschrift Qur'ān Sure IX,33, darum am äußeren Rand Segensworte.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
