Description

Front: Im Feld Glaubenssätze, Ehrenname und Kunya des Familienoberhaupts, innen umlaufend Prägeort und -jahr, aussen umlaufend Koranzitat. Münzzeichen Punkt oben im Feld.

Rear: Im Feld Glaubenssatz, Kalifenname, Ehrenname und Kunya des Prägeherren. Als Randschrift Qur’ān Sure IX,33.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Bisected: The result of intentional division into roughly equal halves.
