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Description

Front: Aufrechtstehende Keule mit überhängendem Löwenfell. Gerahmt von Efeu- und Olivenkranz.

Rear: Dreiteilige Weintraube auf Weinblatt, l. Monogramm aus Π, Ε und Ρ (für Pergamon), oben ΝΙ. Im r. F. von Schlange umwundener Thyrsosstab.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
