Front: Kopf des Herakles mit Löwenfellxuvie nach r.

Rear: Zeus Aetophoros sitzt auf einem Hocker (diphros) ohne Lehne nach l., in der l. Hand ein Zepter. Im l. F. ein Monogramm in einem Kreis über einer liegenden Keule.

Provenience: Durch Prokesch-Osten 1866 in Athen erworben.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
