Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Septimius Severus, l., mit Lorbeerkranz in der Rückenansicht nach r. und drapierte Büste der Iulia Domna, r., in der Brustansicht nach l. einander gegenüberstehend. Zwei runde Gegenstempel Kranz und Kopf des Caracalla dazwischen.

Rear: Kaiserstatue (Augustus?) mit Panzer und Paludamentum steht auf hoher Basis, in der r. Hand Schale (phiale), in der l. Hand Zepter. Davor Opferung eines Zebustieres.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
