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Description

Front: Kopf des Claudius mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Tyche mit Getreidemaß (kalathos) steht in der Vorderansicht nach l. In der r. Hand hält sie ein Steuerruder und im l. Arm ein Füllhorn (cornucopiae). Im l. F. ET / ζΠ (Jahr 86).

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
