## Description

Front: Kreuz, in den Winkeln je eine Kugel.

Rear: Viersäuliger Tempel mit Kreuz in der Mitte und auf dem Giebel.

Cut: Intentional division into smaller parts by cutting, other than halved or quartered.

Reverse reinforced: The practice whereby the reverse of a thin coin (e.g. a medieval bracteate) is reinforced by a collector or a restorer in a museum in order to conserve or stabilise it.
