## Description

Front: Panzerbüste des Hadrianus mit Lorbeerkranz in der Brustansicht nach l.

Rear: Felicitas steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. gewandt. Sie hält in ihrer r. Hand einen Mercurstab (caduceus) und im l. Arm ein Füllhorn (cornucopiae).

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
