Rear: Hadrianus steht in Rüstung in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. Seine r. Hand ist erhoben (adlocutio) und in der l. Hand hält er einen Speer. Zwei Feldzeichen (signa) l., eines r.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.
