Description

Front: Kopf des Hadrianus nach r. Am Hals Gewandspuren.

Rear: Iupiter sitzt auf einem Thron nach l. Er hält eine ihn bekränzende Victoria auf seiner ausgestreckten r. Hand und ein Zepter in der l. Hand.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.

Clipped: Part of the rim of the coin has been removed by clipping in particular with coins made from precious metals.
