Description

Front: Kopf des Hadrianus nach r.

Rear: Hadrianus reitet auf einem Pferd nach r., die r. Hand grüßend (adlocutio) erhoben.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.
