## Description

Front: Drapierte Büste der Faustina maior in der Brustansicht nach r. Graffiti beiderseits des Kopfes.

Rear: Concordia sitzt nach l. Sie hält eine Schale (patera) in ihrer ausgestreckten r. Hand, der l. Arm ist auf eine Statuette der Spes aufgestützt. Unter dem Thron ein Füllhorn (cornucopiae).

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.
