## Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Trebonianus Gallus mit Lorbeerkranz in der Rückenansicht nach r.

Rear: Aequitas steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. In ihrer r. Hand hält sie eine Waage und in ihrer l. Hand ein Füllhorn (cornucopiae).

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.

Overstruck: A coin or medal used as a flan to produce a new coin and that has been struck with a new die.
