Description

Front: Kopf des Divus Augustus mit Strahlenkrone nach l. Oben ein Stern.

Rear: Kopf der Livia mit Schleier (capite velato) nach l. Das Ganze in einem Ährenkranz.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
