Description

Front: Drapierte Büste des Hermes mit Hut (petasos) nach r. Hinter ihm Hermesstab (kerykeion).

Rear: Leier (lyra). Im r. F. ein runder Gegenstempel (Stern).

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
