Description

Front: Panzerbüste des Numerianus mit Lorbeerkranz in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Abundantia steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. gewandt. Sie leert ein Füllhorn (cornucopiae) nach l.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
