## Description

Front: Kopf des Septimius Severus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Caracalla mit Lorbeerkranz, l., und drapierte Panzerbüste des Geta, r., beide in der Rückenansicht, einander gegenübergestellt.

Provenience: Mit der Pfälzer Sammlung 1685 auf dem Erbschaftswage nach Berlin gelangt.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
