## Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Caracalla mit Lorbeerkranz in der Rückenansicht nach r. Kratzer im r. F.

Rear: Victoria geht nach l. Sie hält einen Kranz in ihrer erhobenen r. Hand und einen Palmzweig im l. Arm.

Provenience: Mindestens seit um 1693 im Bestand des Münzkabinetts.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
